The meeting was CALLED TO ORDER at 6:03pm and started with the pledge of allegiance.

Fuel Bids were opened. Main-Care gave prices for unleaded gasoline at a net price of \$2.47, 60/40 diesel at a net price of \$3.20, and Kerosene at a net price of \$3.66 no fixed amounts offered, and no bid on LP gas. John is going to reach out to Mirabito this week for LP gas, which is the heat for the Municipal Building. MOTION to approve bids made by Julie Sechrist, and seconded by Dan Deysenroth. A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by Dan Deysenroth to approve General Fund A, Abstracts dated November 12, 2025, A25142-A25163 for \$4401.22, Fund B 2518 \$3051.26, for a total of \$7452.48.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by David Post to approve the Highway Fund DA and DB. DA 2590-DA25108 for \$22567.92 and DB2529-DB2530 for \$67748.79 for a total of \$90316.71

A MOTION was made by David Post and seconded by Dan Deysenroth to approve SK Sewer SK 2538-SK2542 for \$12887.31.

It was discussed by John Kosier the PILOT program for the Western Catskills to extend their agreement, and Charlie suggested it was raised by 5%, and WC is waiting to hear from their lawyer.

Highway report by Kevin Rinehart, the trucks are all ready for the season, and a radiator was replaced in one of the trucks this week but is back in rotation. Davis Road culvert clean-up when the weather cooperates, and then all projects are wrapped up. A town member suggested the highway crew start at 5am for winter hours as soon as December 1, 2025, to help eliminate some of the overtime rates occurring.

The new website of NY.gov starting in 2026 the agenda will also be uploaded to the website, along with the minutes of the previous meeting, for more of a transparency to the town of Stamford.

A new town lawyer has been hired, Young and Summers, will also be updated on the website.

David Post did a drop by the town garage this past week, and was very impressed with the team, and the conditions of “2012”, a large truck, and hope it has 5 years left of use, but wants to be noted the “little truck” will need to be replaced sooner than later, and something to look into in the coming year.

The noise ordinance suggestion from previous meeting was discussed, and decided against making a noise ordinance for the town of Stamford, as it is found to be unnecessary for the few times there is a complaint.

A MOTION to approve the BUDGET 2026 was made by David Post and seconded by Julie Sechrist, ALL AYE votes case, MOTION carried.
