

The regular monthly meeting of the town of Stamford was held on October 8, 2025 at 6:00 P.M., at the Town of Stamford Municipal Building with the following present:

The meeting was CALLED TO ORDER at 6:03pm and started with the pledge of allegiance.

Ted Kosier started with a recap of the Sausage Festival in August of 2025 serving over one thousand people, and asked the town support in the event next year August 2026, a MOTION was made John Koiser to support the rotary in the festival in 2026 and Dan Deysenroth seconded. ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

George Haynes proposed a location change for Catskill Castings from current location in Bloomville, NY to the "old slaughter house" on River Road Bloomville. A MOTION was made by Dan Deysenroth to approve the site plan review application #1-2025 and seconded by Julie Sechrist ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

Fuel bids were opened. Main-Care gave prices for unleaded gasoline, 60/40 diesel, and Kerosene, no fixed amounts offered, a MOTION to resend the letters and run the advertisement in the paper again was made by John Kosier, and seconded by Dan Deysenroth ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

Representatives of the Weather Station proposed an installation of a Davis Pro2 on the roof of the Town Building at 101 Maple Ave, it is used to inform the residents of the daily weather and can be used by Emergency Services for better preparedness of possible hazardous conditions. A MOTION was made John Kosier to approve the installation next week, October 14-17 2025, and seconded by Julie Sechrist, ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

Henry Lamont spoke for LVDV on the sewer connection for Matthew Knight, it was found to have multiple discrepancies preventing this project from going forward, the resident has 60 days to address the discrepancies and reapply.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by Jake Palmatier to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Dan Deysenroth and seconded by Jake Palmatier to approve the supervisors monthly report. ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried

A MOTION was made by John Kosier and seconded by Dan Deysenroth to approve General Fund A Abstracts dated October 8 2025. Fund A \$2465.00 A25124-A25142, Fund B \$3930.86 B2514-B2517. And Sewer and Light \$78.74 SL2509, for a total of \$7474.60.

A MOTION was made by Julie Sechrist and seconded by Dan Deysenroth to approve highway fund DA and DB, with DA \$11740.28 DA2577-DA2589 and DB \$19392.04 DB 2526-DB2528.

A MOTION was made by Dan Deysenroth and seconded by Julie Sechrist to approve the SK Sewer \$18970.52 for SK2533-SK2537.

A Motion was made by Dan Deysenroth and second by Julie Sechrist to move bill Elan City from highway fund to gen fund. . ALL AYE votes cast, MOTION carried.

Highway report given by Kevin Rinehart, stating the trucks are getting ready for winter weather, the sandpit is full, and the county is supplying salt with the Appalachia company.

It was discussed the missing sign of town on Stamford on rt 23 from grand gorge, and Kevin is looking in to who is responsible for replacing the sign.

A MOTION made by Dan Deysenroth and second by Jake Palmatier for Planning Board members were reappointed, Bill Sechrist, and John Dropp, for a five year term. ALL AYE votes case, MOTION carried.

A MOTION was made by Jake Palmatier and second by Julie Sechrist for Board of assessment review to reappoint Kenneth Grant. ALL AYE votes case, MOTION carried.
